This year, along with our neighboring churches, we hope to help 75 families in our very own community with your generous support.

To help prepare these Christmas baskets, the following donations would be greatly appreciated.

Kindergarten: toothpaste, muffin or cookie mix, cookies, hand soap

Grade 1: crackers, shampoo, cereal, Jell-O

Grade 2: tuna, salmon, canned meat, soup

Grade 3: canned pork & beans, ravioli, instant coffee, tea, toilet paper

Grade 4: canned vegetables, canned fruit (fruit-to-go, apple sauce), pasta, pasta sauce

Grade 5: juice, laundry soap, dish soap, rice, Kleenex

Grade 6: sugar, jam, peanut butter (large), ketchup

The collection of these goods would be appreciated on Friday December 15<sup>th</sup> at the Junior Campus and Thursday December 14<sup>th</sup> 2017 at the Senior Campus.
