<b>Official Communications</b>	
<b>Interim Report</b>	On <b>October 13<sup>th</sup></b> , you will receive the interim report, which will include comments on your child's learning and behavior.
<b>Term 1 Report Card</b>	The Term 1 Report Card will be issued on <b>November 20<sup>th</sup></b> . This report card will cover the period from August 31 <sup>st</sup> to November 10 <sup>th</sup> and will count for 20% of the final mark for the year.
<b>Term 2 Report Card</b>	The Term 2 Report Card will be issued on <b>March 14<sup>th</sup></b> . This report card will cover the period from November 13 <sup>th</sup> to February 23 <sup>rd</sup> and will count for 20% of the final mark for the year.
<b>Term 3 Report Card</b>	The Term 3 Report Card will be issued on <b>June 22<sup>nd</sup></b> . It will cover the period from February 26 <sup>th</sup> to the end of the year and will count for 60% of the final mark for the year.
<b>Parent Interviews</b>	Parents interviews will be held on <b>November 22</b> (3:00 p.m. – 8:30 p.m.) and during the day on <b>November 23</b> (8:30 p.m. – 11:30 a.m.)
<b>Student Portfolios</b>	Student led conferences (portfolio evening) will be held on <b>April 19<sup>th</sup></b> .

<p><b>For Terms 1 and 2</b>, the teacher enters a percentage mark that reflects the knowledge and competencies that a student has acquired - based on the evaluations carried out during the term (tests, assignments, etc.).</p> <p>In the case of English Language Arts, Mathematics and French, Second Language, a <b>Subject Mark</b> is calculated on the basis of the weightings assigned to the subject-specific competencies established by MELS (<i>see subject table on the first page</i>).</p>		<p><b>For the 3<sup>rd</sup> Term</b>, the teacher enters a percentage mark that covers the student's learning as a whole for the year (knowledge and competencies).</p>	<p><i>The 3<sup>rd</sup> term includes a Final Mark.</i></p> <p><i>It is calculated using the results of the three weighted terms (20%, 20%, 60%)</i></p>

<p><b>Comments on Learning (by Subject)</b> The report card will include a section for general teacher comments for each subject area.
