6.1 Call to Order

Having attained quorum, the meeting was called to order by B. Pande at 7:04pm.

6.2 Adoption of the Agenda

12-13-59 It was moved by L. Lecompte to adopt the agenda. The motion was seconded by R. Ethier, and was carried unanimously.

6.3 Adoption of Minutes of April 10th, 2013.

12-13-60 It was moved by L. Sulano to accept the minutes with the corrections. The motion was seconded

by N. Montcalm, and was carried with seven (7) in favor and two (2) abstentions.

6.5 Business Arising

6.5.1 Social Media (Update)

It was agreed upon that the website needed to be revitalized. There are no funds available to venture into the social-media realm.

6.6 New Business

6.6.1 Student Code of Conduct

The structure and presentation of the document has been changed to a very clear and easy to read format. New to the Code, in the School Discipline Policy, are the definitions of the following: Conflict, bullying and violence. This shows the progression of behavior. Also two behaviours to avoid were added:

- "Disrespectful or negative behavior towards fellow students, staff, volunteers and bus drivers both in school and on social media".
- "Disrespectful or non-compliant behavior during school transportation or towards volunteers during carpooling on school trips may result in loss of privileges or other sanctions based on the nature of the act".

This document will be made into a poster and it will be printed in the students' agendas. Also, it will be translated into French. It was suggested that it can be used as a teaching tool.

12-13-61 It was moved by B. Bagshaw to approve the <u>Student Code of Conduct</u> as presented. The motion was seconded by L. Sulano and was carried unanimously.

6.6.2 School Calendar 2013-14

12-13-62 It was moved by N. Montcalm to approve the school calendar for the 2013-14 as presented. The motion was seconded by R. Ethier and was carried unanimously.

6.6.3 Rentals 2013-14

B. Pande suggested to the GB to proceed with the same format as last year's AGM, using the power-point presentation. Both Jr and Sr AGMs will be on the same night, one after the other. Depending on the location, that school will host the first meeting; this will alternate each year. Chairpersons from both schools will determine the location for the next AGM which will take place Wednesday September 11, 2013.
