Punctuality is a Priority



- Ped Day supervision fees are now \$15.75.

Field trips: Due to staffing and bussing limitations, the first 65 regular daycare students will be accepted. Beyond 65 students, there will be a wait list. A total of 10 students is needed on the list to reserve a second bus and hire extra staff. **Non-regular daycare students will automatically be placed on the wait list. Ped Days are reserved for regular users.**
